

# AASL SUMMER HIGH SCHOOL LEAGUE INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

## GENERAL INFORMATION

AASL is a community-based league with teams mainly in the southern and western suburbs of the Greater Cleveland area. During the summer months, AASL offers organized matches at the high school level. Any high school can enter a team or teams to play in this recreational league.

## MATCH FORMAT

The format is for three teams to gather at one site with two 25-minute halves and matches played at 6:00, 7:00 and 8:00 p.m. The home team would play at 6 and 8. Visitor 1 would play at 6 and 7 and Visitor 2 would play at 7 and 8. For those of you who are also high school coaches in the fall, each evening set counts for only one contact. It is not necessary to have a home field. You may play all of your matches away.

## PLAYERS

Players must be currently attending high school (8<sup>th</sup> graders to entering 12<sup>th</sup> graders). Each player must fill out a ***Summer High School Player Registration Form*** and the liability square must be signed by the parent/guardian (if the player is a minor) in order to be placed on the roster. Players must also be provided with a copy of the AASL Policy on Disrespect, Assault, and Abuse of Referees/Players/Coaches/Spectators. Forms can be found on the website under ***HS League or Registration and Forms***.

## COACHES, ROSTERS AND PLAYER PASSES

Coaches are not required to be certified/licensed and there are no roster size limitations in this league. It will be up to the individual teams if they would like player passes or not. If a team requires player passes, each pass will be \$2.00. Blank passes can be obtained through the League Registrar. Passes must be filled out completely, color photos attached and signed by the player. Information on player passes can be found on the AASL website under ***Registration and Forms***. All coaches and those assisting the team must fill out an ***AASL High School Coaches Registration Form*** and an ***OYSAN Risk Management Form (oysan.org)***.

## REGISTRATION AND FEES

Registration begins in May of each year. Games are played in the months of June and July. It is anticipated that the season will start on the week of June 11, 2006. The matches will be played on Monday through Thursday evenings. If the teams prefer, a mini-tournament can be scheduled in mid to late July over one weekend. Registration fee is ***\$30 per player***. This fee covers the tee shirt and insurance. Coaches are not charged a registration fee. A risk management fee of \$5.00 will be charged by OYSAN at the time the form is completed.

There is a ***\$120 declaration bond fee*** due at the first meeting. When this fee is paid it ensures that your team will be included in the league. When the player fees are paid, the bond fee will be deducted from the total. All checks should be made payable to "AASL".

## **REFEREE FEES**

The referee fees will be \$25 per team per game. If you have two games in an evening the total referee fee will be \$50 for the evening. These fees are paid directly to the referee.

## **FORMS**

All high school forms are downloadable at the AASL website, AASLOH.NET, then click on the High School page.

## **MEETINGS**

The league meetings are held at the Cuyahoga Community College, Western Campus, in Parma (CCC). The college is located at the northwest quadrant at the intersection of Pleasant Valley Road and York Road. The meetings are held in the upper cafeteria.

Dates will be announced At beginning of each season.

First League meeting is an informational and intent to participate meeting, deposits are to be paid, please have exact address where your home field(s) are located if possible.

Two Subsequent meetings will be held at CCC West.

A registration meeting when registration forms and rosters are turned in so that the shirts can be ordered.

Meeting At CCC–West in the southeast parking lot where shirts, schedules and rosters will be handed out.
